BEHAVIOR POLICY

Our behavior policy includes a zero tolerance stance for the following behaviors. In the event of any of these behaviors, parents will immediately be called and the student will be dismissed from programming:

Threatening or antagonistic language expressed toward staff or other students; unwanted physical contact both violent and non-violent; harassment, intimidation, or other abusive behaviors; possession of any alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, or firearms on Lyric premises. Refunds will not be given in the case a student is dismissed for any of these behaviors. Please contact Rozz for details on our full behavior policy.

CASTING AND PLACEMENT POLICY

Acceptance into all Production camps/classes is by audition only. Our goal is to give every student the opportunity to excel, and therefore, it is important for each student to have the training, experience, and maturity necessary to achieve success. We will evaluate each student and recommend the appropriate classes, productions, and roles based on what will best suit each student's needs and abilities. There is no guarantee for casting.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Academy productions have fast-paced rehearsal periods followed by full-scale performances in a professional theatre setting. Each cast is a unit and depends on one another to move the show forward. **Students are allowed no more than three absences from rehearsal. No absences are allowed during tech week.** Please inform your director and stage manager of all rehearsal conflicts.

Inform your director as soon as possible if an emergency conflict arises.

The directing team reserves the right to recast any role in which excessive absences affect preparation. NO ABSENCES WILL BE ALLOWED DURING TECH WEEK AND PERFORMANCE DAYS. Absences that occur during Tech Week and performances will adversely affect future casting at the Academy.
