





Advanced Performance Tour Camp

Ages: 12-18 Tuition: \$300

June 20-July 1, 10am-4pm (various times during second week)

This camp will learn and prepare a 40-minute musical theatre show, and will take their show on the road for a community tour of the Metropolitan Library System library locations across the metro. The tour will take place June 27-July 1, and tour schedule will be available at auditions. Performers will travel on the Lyric van with our instructor, Ronn Burton.

One Week Camps

The one-week camps below are open enrollment based on age, and do not require an audition. One-week camps are a great way to get started if your student is too nervous to audition yet! Some one-week camps do not include a performance, but they all offer great training to develop and hone performing skills outside of a production.

Return of the One Week One Act

Ages: 12-18

Tuition: \$350

The One Week One Act camp is one of our most popular acting camps! During this intensive, students will devise (create) and perform a completely original one act from scratch with help from their instructor.

Shiny Little Stars Creative Drama Camp

Ages: 5-7

This camp is for our youngest musical theatre fans! We will spend a week learning, pretending, playing, creating, and of course singing and dancing! This camp teaches important theatre performance skills in an atmosphere of play. Campers will learn stage directions, following instructions in a sequence, vocal projection, and fundamentals of acting.

Audition Prep Workshop is recommended for all students who will be new to our Fall 2022 audition process. This camp is not required, but will be students' most thorough training and preparation for not only the Academy fall audition season, but any audition season your student may be entering.

Private Lesson Instruction

Private Instruction, Voice and/or Acting

Ages 3rd grade - Adult

Full Summer (eight half hour lessons) \$240

Double Summer (16 half hour lessons) \$480

Single Block (four half hour lessons) \$150

Private instruction is available to provide extra training and study in vocal technique and acting. In Summer 2022 private voice lessons will occur in the instructors' studios in the Plaza Theatre. Online virtual lessons will be at the instructors' discretion. If you are new and would like to discuss instructor options, please call the Academy office. The private lesson semester begins May 30th. Unused lessons at the end of the semester will roll to the fall semester.

Tuition and Fees

In addition to the tuition listed by each class, each student will be charged a \$25 per semester non-refundable Registration Fee, which must be paid before attendance at the first class. Tuition must be paid upon registration unless scholarship arrangements are made or payment plans have been established. Call for details.

Withdrawals

Students withdrawing from a class BEFORE THE CAMP BEGINS will receive a full tuition refund (excluding the non-refundable \$25 enrollment fee). Students remaining on the roll after the first day of the camp in which they are enrolled will be responsible for the camp's full tuition. It is the responsibility of the parent, not the instructor, to contact the Director of Education if a student wishes to withdraw from a camp.

Financial Aid

Need-based scholarships are available each semester. A limited number of work study positions are also available. If you are interested in receiving a financial aid scholarship form, please email Rozz@LyricTheatreOKC.org prior to enrollment. Financial Aid is not applicable to Private Instruction. Summer scholarship application deadline is May 15.

Placement

Acceptance into all Production Camps and Advanced Performance Camp is by audition only. Our goal is to give each student the opportunity to excel, and therefore, it is important for each student to have the training, experience and maturity necessary to achieve success. We will evaluate each student and recommend the appropriate classes, productions and roles based on what will best suit each student's needs and abilities.

Forced Closure and Covid Quarantine

In the event that our live camps are forced to quarantine and no longer be in person, we will move to an online format. If we are forced to cancel performances, ticket refunds will be issued. The Thelma Gaylord Academy reserves the right to make instructor changes should an online migration occur. No refunds will be provided should our in-person classes be migrated to an online format. If your student must miss camp because of a Covid exposure quarantine, we will arrange a Zoom meeting to provide access to the class(es) from home.
