

Camp Joseph is a very rare opportunity for students! Instead of performing at Lyric's Plaza Theatre like a typical Academy summer production, this camp will have the exciting priviledge of performing at OKC's Civic Center Music Hall along with the professional cast of the show!

Here are some things to know about Camp Joseph.

#### **Auditions**

Auditioning is required to participate in Camp Joseph. <u>Auditions are March 23rd at the new Lyric Multipurpose Building next to Lyric's Plaza Theatre, 1721 NW 16th Street.</u> You will need to sign up for an auditon time here: tinyurl.com/Sum25AcademyAuditions

On the SignUp Genius link above, you will see all the requirements for your audition, they're also listed on the next page. But! If you do not have a resume, headshot, or music, don't worry. You can still audition! Email Rozz if this is your first audition or if you have any questions about the details.

#### **Tuition**

Tuition for Camp Joseph is \$600. Your tuition can be paid in three monthly payments made in June, July, and August. There are also scholarships available. If you would like to apply for a scholarship, you can find the application on our website or by emailing our office.

#### Ages and Apprentices

Camp Joseph is for students ages 8-15. Students ages 16 through graduated HS seniors can audition for apprentice roles. For details on apprentice auditions, visit LyricTheatreOKC.com/auditions.

#### Schedule and Performances

Our rehearsal schedule will be available at auditions. Some of the times, especially at the Civic Center, may not be exact yet. We'll need to be a little flexible with some end times and be ready for frequent emails that will share details as we know them. We'll have seven performances, opening June 17 and closing June 29 with two shows on Saturday.

--Piano sheet music for the accompanist

### Private Instruction, Voice and/or Acting

Full Summer (eight half hour lessons) \$240

Double Summer (16 half hour lessons) \$480

Single Block (four half hour lessons) \$150

Private instruction is available to provide extra training and study in vocal technique and acting. In Summer 2025 private voice lessons will occur in the instructors' studios in the Plaza Theatre. ## **Technical Theatre Camp**

Ages 12-18 \$400

Be part of the backstage excitement by joining a team that mounts fully staged musicals in a professional theatre. All tech campers will get real world, hands-on experience in technical areas and backstage/booth crew positions. You must be available for ALL camp and performance dates to participate.





## **Details and FAQs**

#### **Tuition and Fees**

In addition to the tuition listed by each class, each student will be charged a \$25 per semester non-refundable Registration Fee, which must be paid before attendance at the first class. Tuition must be paid upon registration unless scholarship arrangements are made or payment plans have been established. Call for details.

#### Withdrawals

Students withdrawing from a class BEFORE THE CAMP BEGINS will receive a full tuition refund (excluding the non-refundable \$25 enrollment fee). Students remaining on the roll after the first day of the camp in which they are enrolled will be responsible for the camp's full tuition. It is the responsibility of the parent, not the student or instructor, to contact the Director of Education if a student wishes to withdraw from a camp.

#### **Financial Aid**

Need-based scholarships are available each semester. A limited number of work study positions are also available. If you are interested in receiving a financial aid scholarship form, please email Rozz@LyricTheatreOKC.org prior to enrollment. Financial Aid is not applicable to Private Instruction. Summer scholarship application deadline is April 18.

#### **Placement**

Acceptance into all Production Camps is by audition only. Our goal is to give each student the opportunity to excel, and therefore, it is important for each student to have the training, experience and maturity necessary to achieve success. We will evaluate each student and recommend the appropriate classes, productions, and roles based on what will best suit each student's needs and abilities.

#### **Forced Closure**

In the case of closure due to severe weather, we will try to make up class time but cannot guarantee that there will be time in the summer for make ups. In the event that our live classes are forced to quarantine due to illness and no longer be in person, we will move to an online format. The Thelma Gaylord Academy reserves the right to make instructor changes should this occur. No refunds will be provided should our in-person classes or camps be migrated to an online format. If your student must miss class because of illness, we will arrange a Zoom meeting to provide access to the class(es) from home if necessary for rehearsal.
